

Budgets

- o The key stages in the planning process and core requirements within the process, such as:
 - Fixed and variable cost assessment
 - How to draw up the budget incremental and zero-based
- o The key stages in the monitoring process and how to control a budget effectively
- Types of variance and actions to be taken
- o People, behaviours, commitment and politics
